 - What is the doing and learning at your site?
 - What do the people at your site mean to you?
 - What is the idealism involved with your site?
 - What are the consequences of service at your site?
- Identification of a film viewed in class and how it relates to your service
- The Marks and Models of the Church in relation to your service.
